May Demonstrator

Lonnie Zarem lives and works in Los Altos Hills. Following art school and several years of oil painting, she started to paint with encaustic wax, a medium consisting of beeswax, resin, and pigment. This means creating an image by painting with blocks of pigmented wax on a hot flat plate, and then placing rice paper on it to absorb the melted wax image, and then pulling it off for a one time print. 
